Born at Sayre, Pa. Age 18-7/12 years.

Enlisted at Camp Syracuse July 10, 1917.

Organizations: Co. I, 23rd Inf. July 10, 1917 to March 9,
1918; headquarters Co., 3rd Brigade, 2d Division to Oct. 5,
1918. Private. Served over-seas Sept. 17, 1917 to Oct. 5,
1918. Died of broncho-pneumonia Oct. 5, 1918.

CATLIN, LEWIS EDWARD, Coxswain, U.S.N.

Enlisted at Rochester, N.Y., May 3, 1917, and sent to Training
Station at Newport, Rhode Island, May 3 to June 15, 1917.

U.S.S. Georgia June 15, 1917 to July 13, 1919; U.S.S. Florida
July 13 to Aug. 13, 1919; Bay Ridge Receiving Ship, Brooklyn, N.Y.
Aug. 13 to Aug. 29, 1919. Discharged at Receiving Ship at New York
Aug. 29, 1919.

CONKLIN, HAROLD WELCHER, Private.

Enlisted at New York City, June 2, 1917. Sent to
Camp Crane, Allentown, Pa., August 1, 1917, and
assigned to Section 560, U. S. Army Ambulance
Service. Sailed from Hoboken, N. J., June 12, 1918,
and arrived at Genoa, Italy, June 27. Served in
Section 560, United States Army Ambulance Ser-
vice with the Italian Army. In American School-
Universite de Clermont-Ferrand, March 1, 1919, to
July 1, 1919. Served with Italian Army. June 27
to September 2, 1918. Battles, St. Mihiel, Septem-
ber 11-21; Argonne, September 21 to November
11. In Army of Occupation at Trier, Germany,
from December 1, 1918, to March 1, 1919. Dis-
charged at Camp Upton, N. Y., July 29, 1919. (Benton)
