KIPP, MISS LOUISE, Dietitian.
Enlisted in Canastota, N. Y., in the Red Cross as Dietitian, March 11, 1918. Called to active service August 24, 1918, at Camp Sherman, Chillicothe, Ohio. July 4, 1919 transferred to Letterman General Hospital, San Francisco, California. Discharged at San Francisco, Cal., March 1, 1920. (Benton).



Pierce, Flora B., R.N.

Enlisted in United States Army Nurses Corps May 14, 1918, and reported for duty at United States Army General Hospital, No. 1, Gunhill Park, New York City. Transferred from Gen. Hospital, No. 1 to Nurse's Mobilization Station, Hotel Holly, N.Y. City, June 26, 1918. Sailed with Base Hospital 29 July 19, 1918, on the S.S. Olympic. Arrived at Southampton, England, about July 25th, and proceeded from there to St. Ann's Road, Tottenham, London, where Base Hospital 29 was established. Remained there until the Unit evacuated the hospital. Sent to Dartford for further orders. Embarked at Liverpool on S.S. Olympic, and reached United States Feb. 19, 1919. Unit sent to Hotel Albert for demobilization. Discharged from active service March 31, 1919.



PLATMAN, LOUISE ADELAIDE, R.N.

Enlisted as American Red Cross Nurse, Home Service, Dec. 11, 1918. No. 34005. Was not called to active service. (Benton.)
