Assigned to 151st Depot Brigade. Volunteered for service in Tank Corps. Left Camp Devens March 21st for Camp Colt, Gettysburg, Pa., and assigned to Company B, 302d Battalion Heavy Tanks. Left Gettysburg last of July for Tobyhanna, Pa. Called from Hoboken, N.J. Sept. 25, 1918, arriving at Liverpool, England, Oct. 7, 1918, member of Co. B, 302d Battalion Tank Corps, Heavy Tank Service. Transferred to Co. C, 328th Battalion, Light Tanks, Nov. 15 1918. Discharged at Camp Meade, Md. April 11, 1919. (Benton)

POOLE, LEDWITH ROBERT, Private.

Assigned to Medical Corps. Transferred to Camp Upton, N. Y., and sailed for France, March 27, 1918, arriving May 6, 1918, with the 306th Field Hospital, 77th Division. The work of the 306th was First Aid in the battle lines. Discharged at Camp Upton, N. Y., May 12, 1919. (Benton).

REED, STUART G., Private.

25-18
Sent to Camp Devens, Mass. Feb. 24th, 1918. From there to Camp Upton, N.Y. Served with 308th Infantry, Co. L, 77th Division. went with A.E.F. to France March 19, 1918: was there until Dec. 24, 1918. Fought on Alsace Lorraine and Aiene Fronts. Lost two fingers of right hand by shrapnel wound. Was in hospitals in Paris and St. Cloud. Was gassed. Was in hospital in Camp Merritt, N.J. with measles, and in hospital in Camp Upton, N.Y. for operation for rupture received in France. Discharged at Camp Upton March 24, 1919.
