Company O was mustered into the service of the State on Nov. 4, 1917, by Captain Hayden C. Bates, of New York City; mustered out of service on March 19, 1919, by Captain Fred C. Scharf, of Elmira. The Company served 1 year, 4 months, and 15 days.

OFFICERS

Cap'tain W. E. DeMell, enlisted Nov. 4, 1917, commissioned First Lieutenant Feb. 24, 1918, and placed in command of the company which was designated Platoon Co. C, with headquarters at Corning; commissioned Captain July 29, 1918, and placed in command of the company which was then designated Company O, 4th Inf. **(Benton.)**
