Pursuant to an Order in Council from the Hon^{ble} Cadwallader Colden Esq^r Lieutenant Governor and Commander in Chief of the Province of New York and the Territories Depending thereon in America bearing Date the Eighth day of February 1764

Survey'd for Moses Campbell late a Serjant in the Second Battalion of His Majestys forty Second Regiment of Foot All that Certain Lot or parcell of Land Situate lying and being on the East Side of Lake Champlain in the County of Albany, being Part or Parcell of a large Tract of Land, and Distinguished in the Map of the said Large Tract by Lot Number Three. Beginning on the NorthSide

of a Highway on Chain North from the NorthEast Corner of a Lot Distinguished in the said Map by Lot Number Two, and runs from the Said place of beginning along the West Side of one other Highway North Seventy Nine Chains, to one other Highway, Then along the South Side of the last mentioned Highway West thirty three Chains. Then South to Lake Champlain. Then along Lake Champlain as it runs to one other Highway laid out between the said Lot Number three and Lot Number Two. Then along the North Side of the last mentioned Highway East to the place where this Lot Number Three first Began Containing two hundred Acres of Land Given under my hand this twenty fifth Day of March One thousand Seven hundred and Sixty five.
