The humble Petition of Sarah Robbins a Free born Indian Woman

Sheweth

N. Y. Feb 16th
 Unto you Excellency that your Petitioner is a Native of this Her Majestys Province and was born of free parents hath lived great part of her time upon Long Island with One John Parker of Southampton and by him was summed over to One John Weeks of Bridgehampton on the said Island who turned her over to Cap. Robert Waller of the City of New York but on what Acc^t. She knoweth not Therof Robert Waller upon the first day of January last caused your Petition against her to be Transported unto the Island of Madras in Order to be there sold or made a Slave but after her arrival in the said place upon her Application to the English Consul and declaring that she was a Free Subject the said Consul so procured that Captain Peter Roland who brought her into the said Island should bring her back again to his Colony She having before refused to become a Slave woman if she would have turned to the Roman Catholic faith and been Baptized And your Petitioner being still informed that she may be further Imposed on and at some time or other Coughly conveyed to some other part of the World under the Notion of a Slave She doth therefore in most humble manner pray that the said John Parker John Weeks or the said Robert Waller may be put to prove their Title to her as a Slave and if they fail therein Then she humbly prayes your Excellencies Protection whereby she may be suffered to live quietly and Safely in this her Native Country as a Free born Subject of the same And she as in Duty bound shall ever pray /
