Come to U. S. 3 years ago. Says she paid her own passage. Has 2 uncles. 1 brother and 1 cousin in U. S. Began work in box factory when 16 years old as turner in for \$4. per week. Wakes advanced to \$4.50, then \$5., then \$5.50 then \$6. At the \$6. wage she became a stripper - wages then advanced to \$6.50, \$7., \$5., \$8.50. Girl does not remember the intervals of time between the advance in her wages. States that she was aided by her relatives until she earned \$6. per week, at which time she became self supporting. Lodging \$3. per month. Breakfast, (ooffee, milk, bread and butter,) 100, which girl cooks herself at home. Lunch purchased from peddler in factory or outside of factory, fish and bread and fruit, or sometimes cheese and bread and fruit, 12¢ to 15¢. Supper, Herring or meat soup with cabbage or some other vegetable, bread, but no butter, 20%.
