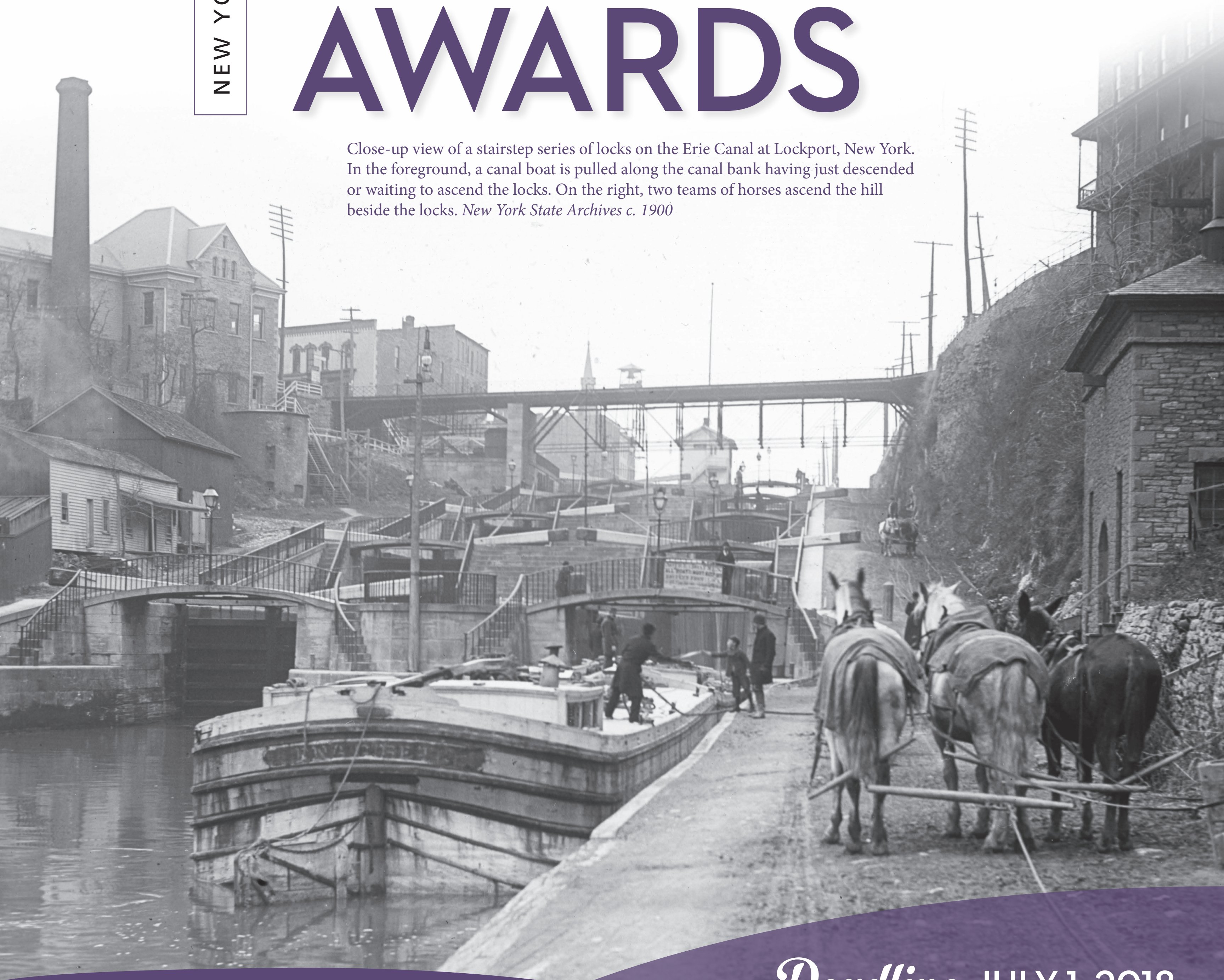


# STUDENT RESEARCH AWARDS
